## HOLIDAY TOURNAMENT

**Tournament Dates: Friday 12/7/18, Saturday 12/8/18, Sunday 12/9/18**

**REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Friday, November 9, 2018**

**\*BELOW, YOU WILL FIND THE NECESSARY INFORMATION, REGARDING THE TOURNAMENT. PLEASE READ EVERYTHING CAREFULLY, PRIOR TO REGISTERING YOUR TEAM. ALL QUESTIONS SHOULD BE DIRECTED TO [gaetanoindooroccer@gmail.com](mailto:gaetanoindooroccer@gmail.com)**

Each team is guaranteed three games. All players participating will receive a tournament tee shirt. The winning team from each age group will receive a trophy. All games will have a winner. In the case of a tie, a penalty shootout will be used to decide the winner. Penalty shootout format will be explained by the referee.

When registering your team, please make sure to fill out the bottom portion of the tournament flyer completely. **Tournament flyers can be printed off the Gaetano Indoor website.** All age groups that are being offered are gender specific. **The age groups that are being offered will be enforced, and all players must be of age at the start of the tournament (12/7/18).** When registering a team, a roster and copies of birth certificates must be handed in. No Exceptions! If you are registering a team for the High School group, players must be in 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade at the start of the 2018/2019 school year. **Keep in mind that school id's may be requested for high school players.** A maximum of 12 players will be allowed on each roster. Changes to rosters can be made up to any time prior to the start of the tournament. Keep in mind that once the tournament officially begins, no changes will be allowed to team rosters. **Players will not be allowed to play on multiple teams within the same age group.**

Once registration has ended, and groups have been finalized, game times and dates will be posted on the Gaetano Indoor website. Teams must be prepared to play on any of the three designated dates, and at any time during said dates. All games will consist of 2 fifteen minute halves. Referees will be instructed to keep games moving. Halftime breaks will consist of 1 to 2 minutes in length. Teams should be ready to play, prior to stepping foot onto the field. **Keep in mind that start times may be altered, once the tournament has started, due to penalty shootouts, injuries, or any other unforeseen problems that may arise. Teams are advised to be at the facility at least 30 minutes prior to game time.**

A minimum of four teams, and a maximum of seven teams per group. In the event that we do not have at least four teams registered in an age group, your money will be refunded. If the number of teams exceed seven, two separate divisions will be made. A blind draw will be used when determining separate divisions within the same age group.

**\*BELOW, YOU WILL FIND TWO RULES/REGULATIONS, THAT TEAMS SHOULD KNOW, PRIOR TO REGISTERING. ALL OTHER RULES/REGULATIONS WILL BE POSTED ON THE GAETANO INDOOR WEBSITE, PRIOR TO THE START OF THE TOURNAMENT**

**1. Number of field players: The 7-8 year old group will be 7 v 7 (6 field players and a goalie). The 9-10, 11-12 & 13-14 year old groups will be 6 v 6 (5 field players and a goalie). The High School group will be 5 v 5 (4 field players and a goalie). The minimum number of players that a team must have on the field to continue playing: 7-8 year old group – 5 total (4 field players and a goalie), 9-10, 11-12, 13-14 & High School groups – 4 total (3 field players and a goalie). Forfeiting will result if a team shows up with less than the minimum number of players required.**

**2. Rosters must be handed in at the time of registration. Rosters can be printed off the Gaetano Indoor website. When filling out the team roster, players' names and date of birth is all that is required. Copies of players' birth certificates must be turned in along with the team roster. Consent waivers must be filled out and signed by a parent or guardian, for each player on the roster. For players participating in the High School group, school id's may be required. Consent waivers must be handed in prior to the start of the tournament. Consent waivers can be located on the Gaetano Indoor website. **When printing out consent waivers from the Gaetano Indoor website, please make sure to use "Youth Consent Waiver." Also make sure that the entire consent waiver is legible, and that no part of the waiver is cut off, after printing. Finally, as the person in charge of the team, it is your responsibility to make sure that each consent waiver is filled out completely, signed and dated, prior to handing them in.****
