Due to the recent executive order, signed by Governor Murphy, Gaetano Indoor will be canceling its Winter I indoor session, for the 2020/2021 indoor season. The Winter I indoor session includes both soccer and lacrosse leagues. Under the new executive order, indoor facilities must not exceed 25% capacity. Based on this number, Gaetano Indoor cannot allow spectators inside the facility. We at Gaetano Indoor apologize for this decision, but after exploring a few different options/plans, it was determined that the only choice was to cancel the Winter I session.

**Keep in mind that as of this moment, Gaetano Indoor has not ruled out a Winter II indoor session. The Winter II indoor session includes both soccer and field hockey leagues. If the capacity level goes up to 50%, we will reevaluate the current situation, and hopefully, be able to run some sort of winter indoor session, beginning sometime in January or February.**

If and when the capacity level is raised to 50%, you will receive an email, stating that registration has begun for the Winter II indoor session. You may also visit the Gaetano Indoor website, from time to time, for updates and information, regarding the indoor season.
